Leaves turn color and drop on some trees and shrubs but they aren't supposed to on evergreens. Be sure your evergreens don't turn brown and drop leaves or needles this winter. Join the many property owners who depend on us to protect their evergreens with antidesiccant.

Pines and other needled evergreens aren't the only ones that need antidesiccant. Broadleaf evergreens like rhododendrons also need this treatment.

Antidesiccant is a wax-like material that we spray on evergreens to reduce water loss that results in winter burn.

Watering **Established**

GUIDE FOR TREES OVER 3 YEARS OLD.

How often you water depends on the size of the tree, soil conditions and weather conditions. The best way to determine when trees need water is to check the soil.

- A deep soaking every 2 weeks is adequate for most trees.
- Focus on watering the entire area beneath the tree's
- Let the water run in one area until the top 8-12 inches of soil is moistened. Move sprinklers as needed to water the entire area underneath the tree's canopy.
- The goal is for moist (not soggy) soil. Deep watering allows critical root zone to take up adequate moisture.
